TIP 1: "If the battle was completely full, for example, all that extra mass makes it harder to spin. That's samething called moment of inertia, basically how much mass you have rotating cround a point of axis."

TIP 2: "There are really two kinds of motion that bottle flipping combines—translational motion, where you're actually going, and then there's rotational motion, where your actual physical bottle is rotating."

TIP 3: "What you're trying to do is get the bottle to be at the right orientation, or at the right amount of turning motion, at the same time it has the same translational motion."

TIP 4: "Once it's in the air, whatever velocity it has and whatever energy it has is what it's going to have, the start to the end of the mation. So, the nice thing about forces is that there's only one force acting on it gravity, downwards."
